Absalom's age – Guess. He could be anywhere from 1-7 y.o. by 2982 AC.

Adonijah's age – Guess. He could be anywhere from 1-7 y.o. by 2982 AC.

Solomon's age – Guess. Solomon is called young when he takes the throne.
